
Worksite – Corpus Christi Ship Channel

Issue Date: March 4, 2024

The Captain of the Port is establishing a safety zone crossing the Corpus Christi Ship Channel, between markers 55 and 56, from March 8th, 2024 through April 15, 2024 between the hours of 9pm and 5am of the next day, every day. The safety zone is needed to protect personnel, vessels, and the marine environment from potential hazards created by vessels in the channel removing pipelines. The coordinates of the work area are: 27° 48' 47.41"N, 97° 16' 49.55"W; 27° 48' 46.55"N, 97° 16' 54.8"W; 27° 48' 28.48"N, 97° 16' 58.94"W; 27° 48' 28.04"N, 97° 16' 51.42"W. No vessels shall transit through the safety zone without permission from the U.S. Coast Guard.

The M/V CAPT TIMMY and M/V HADLEE GRACE will be monitoring VHF Channel 16 and working on VHF Channel 19.
